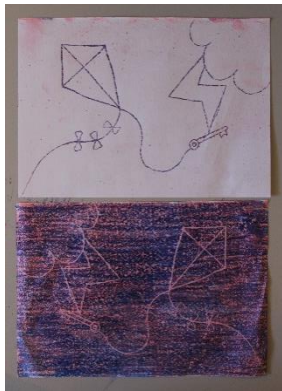
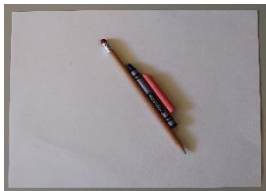


## How to Make a Monoprint



Did you know that Benjamin Franklin started out as a printer? Follow the steps below to create your own simple monoprint. ### You will need:



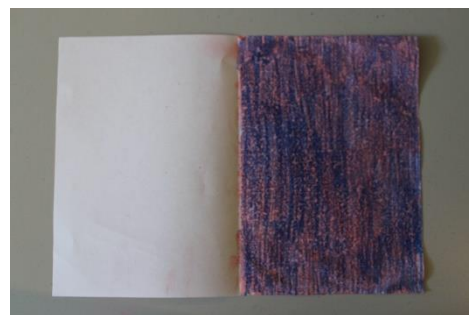
- 1 piece of paper
- 1 sharp pencil
- 1 piece of chalk
- 1 crayon (contrasting colour)

### Step 1



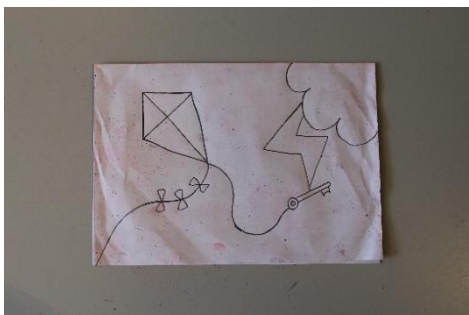
Fold your piece of paper in half and cover one side with chalk.

### Step 2



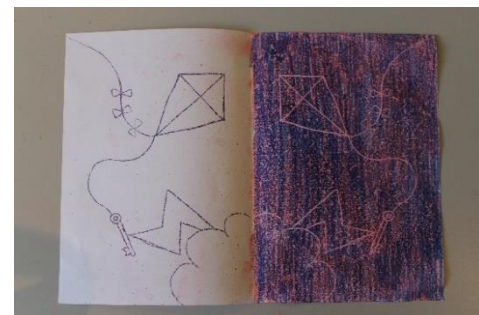
Colour over the chalk with your crayon, completely covering it.

### Step 3



Fold your paper in half and draw your design onto the side which you coloured with the chalk and crayon. You will need to press quite hard.

### Step 4



Open up your paper and you should see two prints! You may want to keep them connected or separate them by cutting down the middle with scissors.
